
## Project #1:

# Baby Blanket

Knitting level: Beginner





Who wouldn't want to wrap their baby in a soft handmade blankie? The pattern combines simple knit and purl stitches to create a textured design. It can be used to keep a baby warm in a stroller, as a play mat on the floor, or as a cozy layer in a crib. Feel free to change the colors and size to fit your needs!

And remember, you can always access your digital pattern with quick scan of the QR code!



#### **Materials:**

- Harmony Wool (light purple 14374) 50g, (white 2031) 50gr, (dark purple 14594) 50gr
- · Darning needle

- · US 7 (4.5mm) circular needles from your previous boxes
- · Scissors

#### Stitches and abbreviations used:

- · K knit
- · P purl
- · SI slip
- · Sts stitches

- · Pm place marker
- · Rs right side
- · Ws wrong side
- · Sm slip marker

#### Sizing of the project:

· Length - 24 inches

### Gauge:

· 18 sts, 32 rows –
4 inches x 4 inches in garter stitch

· Width - 19 inches

#### **Colors:**

- · Color A light purple (14374)
- · Color B white (2031)
- · Color C dark purple (14594)

#### **Pattern**

Cast on 91 sts with light purple (Color A)

#### **Row 1-15**


SI1, k90. (Image 1)

#### **Row 16 (RS)**

SI1, k8, pm, k73, pm, k9. (Images 2-3)

#### **Row 17 (WS)**

SI1, k8, sm, p73, sm, k9. (Image 4)



#### **Row 18 (RS)**

SI1, k8, sm,k1, \*p1, k1\* repeat from \* until marker, sm, k9. *(Image 5)* 

#### **Row 19 (WS)**

SI1, k8, sm, p73, sm, k9. (Image 6)

Repeat Rows 16 -19 eleven more times (you will finish using light purple on Row 63). *(Image 7-11)* 

Cut the yarn and switch to white (Color B).

#### **Rows 64 - 67**


SI1, k8, sm, k73, sm, k9. *(Images 12-13)* 

#### **Row 68 (RS)**

SI1, k8, sm, k73, sm, k9.

#### **Row 69 (WS)**

SI1, k8, sm, p73, sm, k9.



#### **Row 70 (RS)**

SI1, k8, sm, k1, \*p1,k1\* repeat from \* until marker, sm, k9.

#### **Row 71 (WS)**

SI1, k8,sm, p73, sm, k9. (Image 14)

Repeat Rows 68-71 thirteen more times. (Images 15-17)

#### Rows 124 - 127

SI1, k8, sm, k73, sm, k9. *(Image 18)* 

Cut the yarn and switch to dark purple (Color C).

#### **Row 128 (RS)**

SI1, k8, sm, k73, sm, k9. (Image 19)

#### **Row 129 (WS)**

SI1, k8, sm, p73, sm, k9.

#### **Row 130 (RS)**

SI1, k8, sm, k1, \*p1,k1\* repeat from \* until marker, sm, k9. (Image 20)

#### **Row 131 (WS)**

SI1,k8, sm, p73, sm, k9. Repeat Rows 128-131 eleven more times. (Images 21-24)

#### Row 176-190

SI1, k90.


#### **Finishing**

Cast off and weave in the ends using a darning needle. To block the project, wet the project slightly and let it dry on a flat surface.
