Project #2:

Bathroom Essentials Organizer

Crocheting level: Intermediate





With this crochet organizer, there will be no more bathroom clutter! It's perfect for holding toiletries and other small items and looks great hanging on your wall!

And remember, you can always access your digital pattern by scanning the QR code!



Materials:

- 90 grams of Eco Essence in ivory (2)
- · US Size 8 (5mm) crochet hook from your previous boxes
- · Measuring tape
- · Tapestry needle

Stitches and abbreviations used:

- · Ch chain
- · Dc double crochet
- · RS right side
- · Sc single crochet

- · SI st slip stitch
- · St(s) stitch(es)
- · WS wrong side

Size:

· Approx. 11 3/4" wide and 16 1/2" long (including hanging loop)

Base of the organizer

Row 1 (RS)

Ch39, starting in third ch from the hook(first 2 chs count as 1 dc throughout pattern), 1dc in each ch, turn your work after each row. [38 dc]

Rows 2(WS)-29

Ch2(counts as 1 dc throughout pattern), 37dc. [38 dc]

Note: Make sure to occasionally check that each row has 38 dc. The last dc of each row is worked in the top of ch2, which counts as the first dc throughout the pattern.

Fasten off and weave in the ends. (Images 1-3)

Pocket (make 2)

Row 1

Ch32, starting in the second ch from the hook, 1sc in each ch, turn your work after each row. [31 sc]

Row 2

Ch1(does not count as st throughout pattern), 1sc, *skip 2 sts, 5dc in the next st, skip 2 sts, 1sc in the next st; repeat from * to the end of the row. [5 shells]

Row 3

Ch2(counts as first dc throughout pattern), 2dc in the first st, skip 2 sts, 1sc in the next st, skip 2 sts, *5dc in the next st, skip 2 sts,


1sc in the next st, skip 2 sts; repeat from * until the last st, 3dc in the last st. [4 shells, 2 partial shells]


Repeat Rows 2-3 until the pocket measures 5" in length. Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing. (Images 4-8)

Sew the pockets to the base of the organizer. See photos for placement of pockets. (Image 9)









Sew a line in the center of each pocket after attaching it to the base to divide the large pocket into 2 individual smaller pockets. (Image 10)

Hanging loop of the organizer

Join yarn with a sl st to the 15th st of the last row of the base.

Row 1 (RS)

Ch1(does not count as st throughout pattern), 10sc, turn your work after each row. [10 sc]

Row 2 (WS)

Ch1, 2sc, ch6, skip 6 sts, 2sc. [4 sc, 1x ch6-space]

Rows 3-5

Ch1, 10sc.

Fasten off and weave in the ends. (Images 11-13)

And you are done!
