

# Project #1: Breezy Knit Bandana

Knitting level: Beginner



Whether you're dressing up for a casual outing or just want something light to wear around your neck on a breezy day, this knitted bandana is an excellent **addition to your accessories collection**. It's also a fantastic way to protect against the sun or **add a pop of color** to your daily look.

Please note that the yarn color in the instructional photos may vary from the color in your box.

*And remember, you can always access your digital pattern with **quick scan of the QR code!***



### Materials:

- Half a skein of Cotton Blossom yarn
- US 6 (4.0mm) straight needles  
(from your previous boxes)
- Scissors

### Terms used/abbreviations:

- K - knit
- P - purl
- K2tog - knit two together
- Yo - yarn over
- Kfb - knit front and back
- RS - right side
- WS - wrong side

## Bandana pattern

Even rows are WS of the project and odd rows are RS. All WS rows are purl rows – you purl all sts.

Cast on 4.





Special stitch kfb (knit front and back) to make kfb st. You should knit in the front side of the needles and knit in the same st from the back side of the needles. As a result, you will have 2 sts knitted in one st. (images 2, 3, 4, 5)


