Bubbly Bathroom Set (Bath scrub)

Crochet level: Intermediate



This set consists of two projects in one. A handmade scrub to exfoliate and refresh your skin. Plus, a soap saver to keep your soap dry and last longer! Pick your favorite yarn colors or add embellishments to match your bathroom theme.

Both of these projects are quick, easy, and great for giving as gifts to each member of your family or friend group!

And remember, you can always access your digital pattern with a **quick scan of the QR code!**




Materials:

- One skein of Cotton Velour yarn
- US size 3 (3,25 mm) crochet hook
- Scissors

Stitches and abbreviations used:



- Magic circle
- Ch - chain
- St(s) - stitch(s)
- Sc - single crochet
- Dc - double crochet
- Sl - slip stitch
- Dc3inc – double crochet increase – double crochet 3 in the same st
- Dc4inc – double crochet increase – double crochet 4 in the same st
- Dc5inc – double crochet increase – double crochet 5 in the same st

Ch4 and sl in the 1st st (magic circle). (images 1, 2)



Round 1

Sc12 in the circle. Ch40 and sl in the 1st st (ch40 will be strap). (images 3, 4)



Round 2

Ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), dc1 in the same st, 2dc in each st around, sl st in the top chain of ch3 (36 in total). (images 5, 6, 7)



Round 3

Ch3, dc3 in the same st, dc4inc in every st. Sl in the 3rd chain of ch3 (144 dc in total). (images 8, 9, 10)



Round 4

Ch3, dc4 in the same st, dc5inc in every st. Sl in the 1st st (720 st in total). (image 11)

Your bath scrub is ready!



Project #2B:

Bubbly Bathroom Set (Soap saver)

Crochet level: Advanced



With this crocheted soap saver, your soap will stay dry and last longer. Plus, a handmade scrub will exfoliate and refresh your skin. Pick your favorite yarn colors or add additional embellishments to match your bathroom theme.

Materials:

- One skein of Cotton Velour yarn
- US size 3 (3.25 mm) crochet hook
- Scissors

Stitches and abbreviations used:

- Magic circle
- Ch - chain
- St(s) - stitch(s)
- Sc - single crochet
- Dc - double crochet
- Sl - slip stitch
- Dc2inc - double crochet 2 in the same stitch

Make a loop, ch4, and sl in the 1st st (magic circle). (images 1, 2)



Round 1

Dc10 in circle, sl in the 1st st. (image 3)



Round 2

Ch3 (counts as the 1st dc), dc in the same st, dc2inc in every st, sl in the 3rd ch of ch3 (20 dc in total). (images 4, 5)



Round 3

Ch3, dc in the same st, dc2inc, dc2inc, dc4, dc2inc, dc2inc, dc2inc, dc2inc, dc2inc, dc4, dc2 in each of next 3st, sl in sl in the 3rd ch of ch3 (32sts in total). (image 6)



Round 4

*Ch7, skip 3sts, sc in the 4th st.

Repeat * this pattern till the end of the round,, when you make the last ch7, sl in the 1st ch7 space.

Rounds 5-8

Repeat round 4 instructions for 4 more rounds. (images 7, 8, 9, 10)



Round 9

Ch1, sc3 in the same ch7 space, sc4 in each of next ch7 spaces, sl in the 1st ch1 st (32 in total). (images 11, 12)



Round 10

Ch1, sc32, sl in the 1st st.

Round 11

Ch1, sc7, ch20, sl in the same st, sl in the next st and ch20, sc1 in the same st, sc24, sl in the 1st st. (image 13)



Round 12

Ch1, sc in all sts, ch20 sts included. Sl in the 1st st, ch1, and cut the yarn.
