

## Project #3:

# Effortless Elegance Beret

Knitting level: Advanced



Whether you're aiming for a chic Parisian look or simply want to keep warm in style, this DIY beret is the perfect accessory!

Please note that the yarn color in the instructional photos may vary from the color in your box.

And remember, you can easily access your digital pattern **by scanning the QR code!**



### Materials:

- Two skeins of Cotton Cloud yarn
- US 8 (5.0mm) circular needles
- Sewing needle
- Stitch markers

### Terms used:

- CO - cast on
- K - knit
- P - purl
- M1 - make one
- K2tog - knit two together

CO72.

### Row 1

K72.

### Row 2

\*K1, p1. Repeat \* this pattern till the end of this row.

### Rows 3-8

Repeat row 2. (image 1)



### Row 9

K72 (image 2)

### Row 10 (increase round)

\*K2, M1. Make 108 stitches in total. (images 3, 4 ,5)



### Row 11

K108

### Row 12(increase round)

\*K18, M1. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 114 stitches.

### Row 13

K114

### Row 14 (increase round)

\*K19, M1. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the round, making 120 stitches.



### Row 15-17

K120 (image 6)

### Row 18

\*K13, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 112 stitches.

### Row 19

K112 (image 7)



### Row 20

\*K12, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 104 stitches.

### Row 21

K104

### Row 22

\*K11, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 96 stitches.

### Row 23

K96

### Row 24

\*K10, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 88 stitches.

### Row 25

K88

### Row 26

\*K9, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 80 stitches.

### Row 27

K80

### Row 28

\*K8, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 72 stitches.

### Row 29

K72

### Row 30

\*K7, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 64 stitches.

### Row 31

K64 (image 8)



### Row 32

\*K6, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 56 stitches.

### Row 33

K56

### Row 34

\*K5, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 48 stitches.

### Row 35

K48

### Row 36

\*K4, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 40 stitches.

### Row 37

K40

### Row 38

\*K3, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 32 stitches.

### Row 39

K32

### Row 40

\*K2, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 24 stitches.

### Row 41

K24

### Row 42

\*K1, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 16 stitches.

### Row 43

K16 (image 9, 10)

### Row 37

K40

### Row 38

\*K3, k2tog. Repeat \* this pattern until the end of the row, making 32 stitches.

Bind off all stitches. Sew the sides and top of the beret using a sewing needle. (image 11, 12)
