Project #1:

Fingerless Gloves

Knitting level: Beginner





This project uses simple techniques and minimal materials to create a cozy pair of gloves. By leaving your fingers open, these gloves provide the comfort needed for everyday tasks like typing, texting, and handling small objects without needing to remove them. This makes them ideal for indoor use, such as in chilly offices or homes.

Materials:

- · US size 4 (3.5 mm) circular knitting needles
- · 30 grams of Mystic Merino in a light blue color (18)
- · 30 grams of Mystic Merino in a yellow color (21)
- · Scissors
- · Stitch marker
- · Sewing needle

Terms and symbols used:

- · K knit (V)
- · P purl (-)
- · SI slip
- · St stitch
- · Sts stitches

- · SM stitch marker
- · K2tog knit two together (λ)
- · Yo varn over (∩)
- · WS wrong side
- · RS right side

Part 1

Cast on 37 sts with color 18 (light blue).

Row 1 and all odd rows, including row 19 - sl 1st st with yarn in back, k36.

Row 2 and all even rows, including row 20 - sl 1st st with yarn in front, p36.

Repeat these two rows until 20 rows are complete.

Part 2


Decrease:

Row 21 and all odd rows

SI 1st st, k2tog, k all sts until last three sts - k2tog, k1.

Row 22 and all even rows

SI 1st st, p all sts. (images 1, 2, 3)



Repeat row 21 and row 22 and decrease sts until 2 st left. Cast off. (images 4, 5, 6)

Part 3
Cast on 37 sts with color 21 (yellow).

Row 1

SI 1st st, *k1, p1.

Repeat *this pattern until the end of the row.

Row 2

SI 1st st, *p1, k1.

Repeat *this pattern until the end of the row.

Row 3, 7, 11, 15, 19

SI 1st st, k2tog, k1, p1 until last three sts: k2tog, k1.

Row 4, 8, 12, 16, 20

SI 1st st, * k1, p1.

Repeat *this pattern until the end of the row.

Row 5, 9, 13, 17, 21

SI 1st st , k2tog, p1, k1 until last three sts: k2tog, k1.

Row 6, 10, 14, 18, 22


SI 1st st, * p1, k1.

Repeat *this pattern till the end of the row. After row 22, you will be left with 17 sts.

Part 4

Put an SM on the 9th st. (image 7)

Rows 23-35



Row 23 and all odd rows, including row 35

SI 1st st, k2tog, k5, yo before SM, k1, yo after SM k5, k2tog, k1. (image 8)

Row 24 and all even rows, including row 34

SI 1st st, p16. (images 9, 10)

Part 5

As shown in the photo below, take both parts of the project from the RS and sew them from the WS. (images 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18) $\,$

Make a second glove following the same instructions.
