# Project #2:

# Handy Hook Case

Knit level: Intermediate





Time to stitch up something special for your tools – a handy hook case!

Perfect for crafters with a bit of experience under their belt. Keep your hooks snug and sorted wherever you go.

Please note that the yarn color shown in the instructional photos may vary from the color included in your box.

You can access your digital pattern with a **quick scan** of the **QR** code!



#### Materials:

- · One and a half skeins of Cotton Reef yarn
- US size 6 (4mm) crochet hook (from your previous boxes)
- · Darning needle
- · Measuring tape
- · Scissors

### Stitches uses/abbreviations:

- · Magic Circle
- · Ch chain
- · St(s) stitch(es)
- · Sc single crochet
- · Hdc half double crochet
- · SI slip stitch

# The main part of the case:

#### **Round 1**

Ch 31.

Hdc30, turn the project. (image 1)

\*Ch1, hdc30, turn the project.

Keep crocheting till the length of the project reaches 38-40cm (around 15-15.5 inches). (images 2, 3)







#### Part 2 (big pocket)

Fold one end of the case to create a pocket (7-8 cm, 3-3.5 inches). (image 4)

Take a needle and sew the sides together. (image 5)





# Part 3 (hook pockets)

Ch 18.

Sc 17, turn around.

\*Ch1, sc17, turn the project. (images 6, 7)

Repeat \*this pattern till the length of the project reaches 10 cm, around 4 inches vertically. (image 8)  $\,$ 










And 13-14 cm (around 5-5.5 inches) diagonally.

Sew it to the pattern.

Sew spaces for the hooks. It is better to put the hooks inside to determine where to sew better. (image 9)

## Part 4 (stitch markers holder)

Ch 10 and attach it to the pattern. (image 10)





Part 5 (measuring tape holder)

Ch 11.

Sc10, turn around.

Ch1, sc10.

Attach it to the project. (images 11, 12, 13)





# Part 6 (needle holder)

Ch 9.

Sc 8, turn around.

\*Ch1, sc8, turn around.

Repeat \*this pattern for 2 more rows (4 rows in total) and sew it to the project. (images 14, 15, 16)







# Part 7 (little pocket)

Ch 11.

Sc10, turn the project.

\*Ch1, sc10, turn the project.

Repeat \*this pattern for 8 more rows (10 rows in total). (image 17)





Sew it into the pattern.

Attach the yarn to the side of the big pocket, ch 80, and tie the case with this chain. (image 18)
