

Project #2: Rabbit Lovey

Crochet level: Intermediate



Welcome an adorable crochet bunny into your home! This handmade toy is a perfect addition to any nursery or child's bedroom with its soft colors, textured blanket, and charming embroidered features. Follow along with the detailed pattern and create a cherished keepsake.

Materials:

- Woodland Whisper Color 01 – 50 g, Color 19 – 50 g
- 5 mm crochet hook
- Scissor
- Sewing needle
- Stitch marker
- Fiber fill – 10 g

Stitches and abbreviations used:

- Ch - chain
- St - stitch
- sl-st - slip stitch
- dc - double crochet
- Sc inc - 2 sc in the same st.
- Sc dec - insert the hook into the next st, yarn over, pull through, insert the hook into the next st, yarn over, pull through, yarn over, and pull through all 3 loops.
- Special stitch: Large shell - (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in same space

Gauge –14 sc and 4 rows to 4 inches / 10 cm.

Head

With Color 01, make a magic ring (ch4 and sl-st to the 1st st). (Image 1)

Round 1

Make 6sc in the magic ring. Sl-st to the 1st st. (Image 2)

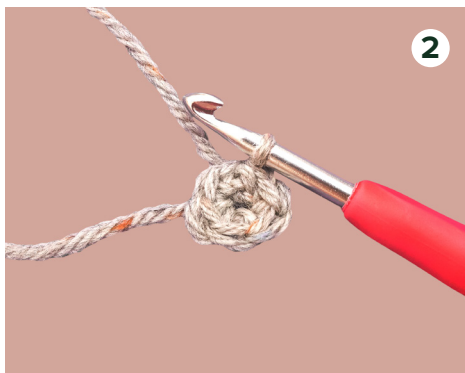
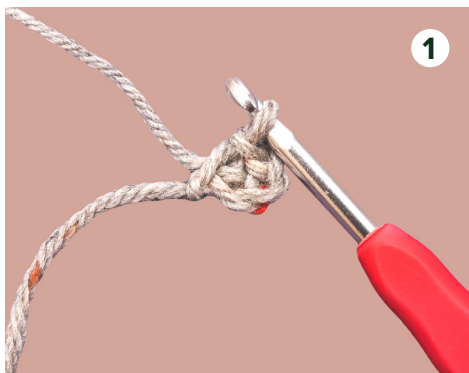
Round 2

Sc inc in each of the next 6 sts. (12 sc)

You can put a stitch marker in the 1st st to mark the beginning of the round. Move the stitch marker up on each row. (Image 3)

Round 3

*Sc inc in the next st, 1sc in the next st. Repeat from * till the end of the round. (18 sc)

Round 4

*Sc inc, 2sc in the next 2 sts. Rep from * till the end of the round. (24 sc)

Round 5

*Sc inc, 3sc in the next 3 sts. Repeat from * till the end of the round. (30 sc)

Rounds 6-11

1sc in each st. (Images 6, 7)



Round 12

*3sc, sc dec. Repeat from * till the end of the round. (24 sc) (Images 8, 9)



Round 13

*2sc, sc dec. Repeat from * till the end of the round. (18 sc)

Round 14

*1sc, sc dec. Repeat from * till the end of the round. (12 sc)

Stuffing

Stuff the head with approx. 5 g of cotton wool or stuffing, or to the desired firmness. (Image 10)

Round 15

Sc dec in each st. (6 sc)

Leave a tail approx. 15 inches long for sewing up, cut the yarn and fasten off.



Eyes and nose

Embroider the eyes and nose as pictured using a piece of Color 19 yarn and a sewing needle.

Thread the yarn through the sewing needle. Insert the needle from the back of the head, pull it through the front, and leave a loop of yarn. Insert the needle through the next stitch diagonally (as pictured), then take the loop of extra yarn, wrap it behind the needle, and insert the needle back in at the start of the stitch, so you have two diagonal lines for the eye. Repeat for the second eye.

Make a vertical stitch for the nose. To finish, take the needle and yarn through the head to the back of the work again and trim both ends of the yarn. (Images 11-15)

Ears (make 2)

With Color 1, make a magic ring.

Round 1

5sc in the ring and sl-st to 1st st to join.

Round 2

4sc, sc inc in the last st. (6 sc)

Round 3

*1sc, sc inc, repeat from * twice more. (9 sc)

Rounds 4-8

1sc in each st.

Round 9

Sc dec, 2sc, sc dec, 3sc. (7 sc)

Rounds 10-13

Sc in each st for 4 more rounds. Leave a 15

inch tail, cut the yarn and fasten off.

Arms (make 2)

With Color 01, make a magic ring.

Round 1

6sc in the ring and sl-st to first st to join.

Round 2

Sc inc in each st (12 sc).

Round 3-5

1sc in each st.

Round 6

Sc dec, 4sc, sc dec, 4sc (10 sc).

Rounds 7-12

1sc in each st.

Leave a 15 inch tail, cut the yarn, and fasten off.

Stuff both arms. (approx. 0.5 g for each arm)

The blanket

With Color 19, make a magic circle.

Round 1

Ch4, (ch3 counts as 1st dc throughout), *1dc into the ring, ch1, Rep from * 6 more times. (8 dc and ch1, including 1st ch4).

Sl-st in the 3rd st of ch4. (Images 16-19)



Round 2

Sl-st into the first ch-1 space, ch3, 1dc in the same space, ch2, *2dc into the next ch-space, ch2. Repeat from * till the end. Sl-st in the 3rd st of the ch3. (Image 20)

Round 3

Sl-st into the 1st dc, sl-st into the ch-space, ch3, 1dc in the same space, ch2, 2dc into the same space. *Work large shell into the next space. Repeat from * till the end of the round. Sl-st in the 3rd st of ch3. (Image 21)



Round 4

Sl-st into the next dc, sl-st into ch-space, ch3, *Large shell in ch-space, 1dc in the next st, skip the next 2 sts, 1dc in the next st. Rep from * till the end of the round.

Change color at the end of the round: insert the hook into 3rd st of ch3 and sl-st with color 01. (Images 22, 23)



Round 5

Sl-st in the next dc, ch3, dc in the next st, large shell in the next space, 2dc, skip 2 sts, *2dc, large shell, 2dc, skip 2 sts. Repeat from * till the end of the row. Sl-st in the 3rd st of ch3. (Image 24)



Round 6

Sl-st in the next dc, ch3, 2dc, *large shell in the next space, 3dc, skip 2 sts, 3dc. Repeat from *till the end of the round. Sl-st in the 3rd st of ch3.

Round 7

Sl-st in the next st, ch3, 3dc, *large shell in the next space, 4dc, skip 2 sts, 4dc. Repeat from *till the end of the round. Sl-st in the 3rd st of ch3.

Round 8

Sl-st in the next st, ch3, 4dc, *large shell in the next space, 5dc, skip 2 sts, 5dc. Repeat from * till the end of the round, Sl-st in the 3rd st of ch3, switching to color 19 again.

Round 9

Sl-st in the next st, ch3, 5dc, *large shell in the next space, 6dc, skip 2 sts, 6dc.

Repeat from *till the end of the round. Sl-st in the 3rd st of ch3.

Round 10

Sl-st in the next st, ch3, 6dc, *large shell in the next space, 7dc, skip 2 sts, 7dc.

Repeat from *till the end of the round. Sl-st in the 3rd st of ch3.

Round 11

Sl-st in the next st, ch3, 7dc, *large shell in the next space, 8dc, skip 2 sts, 8dc.

Repeat from *till the end of the round. Sl-st in the 3rd st of ch3.

Round 12

Sl-st in the next st, ch3, 8dc, *large shell in the next space, 9dc, skip 2 sts, 9dc.

Repeat from *till the end of the round. Sl-st in the 3rd st of ch3.

Cut the yarn & fasten off.

Attach head and arms to the blanket

Take one ear and sew the edges of one end together using the yarn tail and sewing needle. Repeat for the other ear and attach the ears to the head. (Image 25)

Attach the arms to the base of the head.

Place the head in the middle of the blanket and sew it in place using the yarn tail and sewing needle. (Images 26)
