
## Project #3:

# **Snug Fit Socks**

Level: Advanced





These colorful crochet socks are very fun. The leg portion features fun color-blocking, while the cuff uses a unique technique to create a snug, ribbed effect. With sizing instructions for various foot lengths and widths, you can create a perfect fit for anyone!

And remember, you can always access your digital pattern with a **quick scan of the QR code!** 



### **Materials:**

- Fusion Woo (light green 7280) 45g,
   (white 10001) 25 g, (dark green 19059) 50g.
- · Scissors

- · US size 6 (4 mm) hook from your previous boxes
- · Sewing needle

#### Stitches and abbreviations used:

- · Ch chain
- · St stitch
- · Yo yarn over
- · SI-st slip st
- · Sc single crochet
- · Hdc half double crochet (yo, insert the hook into the loop, yo, pull through (3 loops on the hook), yo, pull through all 3 loops)

- · BLO back loop only
- · Hdc dec hdc decrease (yo, insert the hook into the loop, yo, pull through (3 loops on the hook), go into the next st, yo, pull through (4 loops on the hook), yo and pull through all 4 loops)
- · Hdc inc work 2 hdc in the same st
- · Rep repeat

### Gauge:

· 15 hdc sts and 10 rows in 4 inches

#### Colors:

- · Color A light green (7280)
- · Color B white (10001)

· Color C - dark green (19059)

\*Note - For a custom length, repeat Row 11 until the piece reaches the bottom of your big toe. Change to Color A at the end of the last row. (Images 7-8)



\*Note - in case you worked additional rows in the "Sole" section, make sure to work the corresponding additional number of rows in the "Bridge" section as well.





Ankle - with Color A (Images 13-16)

\*Note: When making the ankle extensions, check whether the chain stitches fit comfortably around the ankle. If not, add more stitches on the sides until you feel comfortable with the tightness of the project.

<sup>\*</sup>Note - To make the sock longer, you can continue repeating the last rows.



## Cuff – with Color C (dark green) (for all sizes)

### Row 1

Ch7, turn the work, starting in the 2nd ch from the hook, sc6. SI-st in 1st and 2nd sts of the last row of the Ankle. *(Images 17-19)* 

#### Row 2

Turn the work clockwise, skip the 2 sl-sts, sc6 blo. *(Images 20-21)* 

## Row 3

Ch1, turn the work and 6sc blo, sl-st in the next 2 sts of the last row of the Ankle.

Repeat Rows 2-3 until all the Ankle sts have been joined to the cuff.

## **Sewing the Sock**

Ch1 and cut the yarn, but leave 12 inches for sewing up.

Turn the sock inside out and sew the edges of the cuff and ankle rows together (this will be the center back of the leg). (Image 22)




Starting from the heel, fold the heel in half at the narrowest point and sew the edges of the heel together. (Images 23-24)

Fold the sock in half at the narrowest point of the toe, with the bridge on top of the sole. Join together along the row ends, from the toe up the sides of the foot to the beginning of the ankle. (Image 25)

Finally, sew the top edge of the heel to the ankle to close the last seam.

Fasten off, weave the loose ends and turn your project the right way out. (Image 26) Make one more sock to complete the pair! (Image 27)

Your project is ready!
