

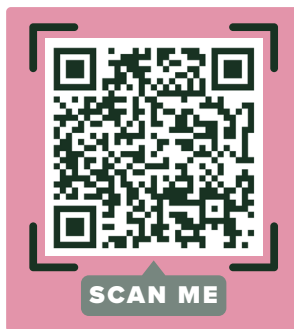
Project #1: Table Topper

Level: Easy



This knitting project creates an elegant, lacy table mat. The design combines various knitting techniques to create a stunning table centerpiece. The design incorporates delicate yarn overs, strategically placed decreases and increases to create a beautiful, radial lace pattern.

Materials:

- Merino Elegance (white 978) – 50 g
- US size 4 (3.5 mm) circular needle (from your previous boxes)
- US size 4 (3.5 mm) double pointed needles (from your previous boxes)
- Stitch markers

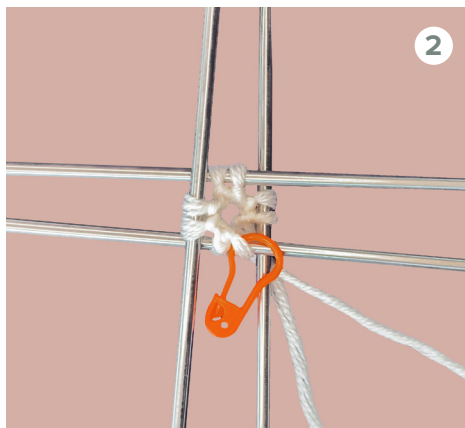
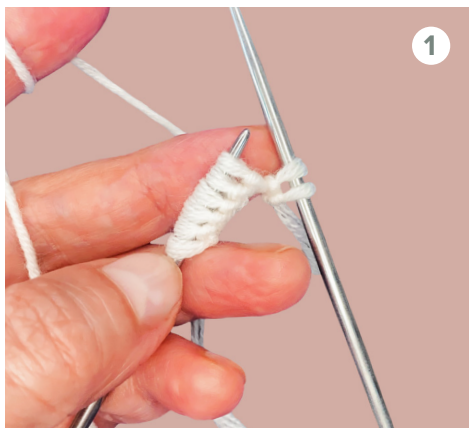
Stitches and abbreviations used:

- k - knit
- p - purl
- sl - slip
- st(s) - stitch(es)
- YO - yarn over
- k2tog - knit two together
- dpn - double pointed needles
- sm - stitch marker
- sk2p - slip, knit two together, pass slipped stitch over

Measurements: 15" diameter

Pattern

Cast on 8 sts using 2 dpn. Distribute all sts onto 4 dpn. Place sm at the beginning of the round. (Images 1, 2)



Round 1 and all odd rows

K all sts. (Image 3)

Round 2

*YO, k1.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.
(Image 4)

Round 4

*YO, k2.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.
(Image 5)

Round 6

*YO, k3.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 8

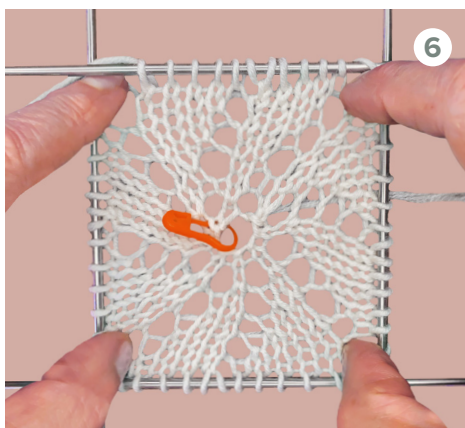
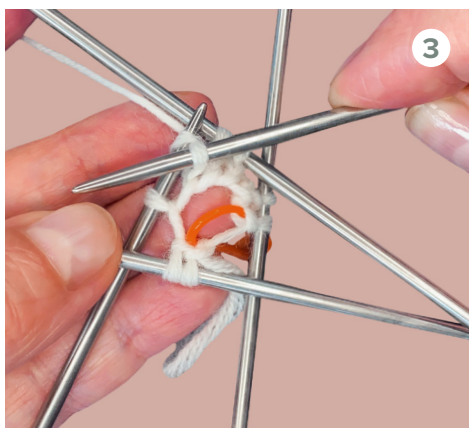
*YO, k4.

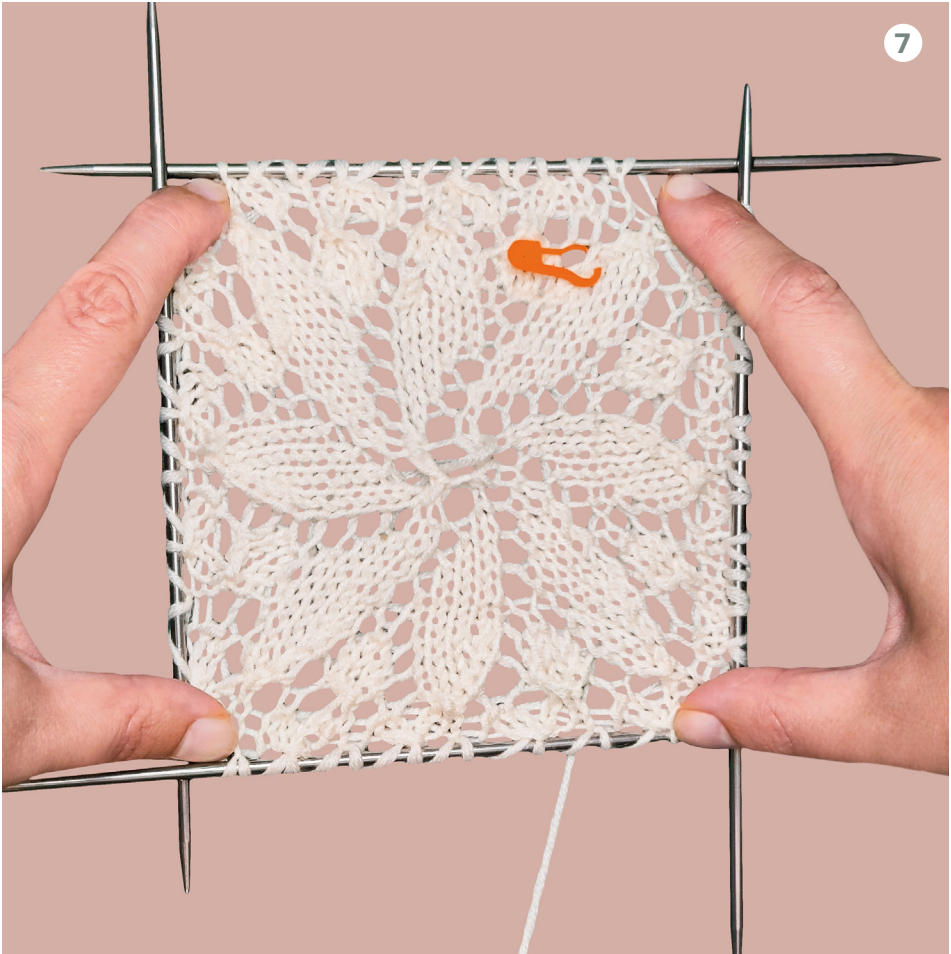
Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 10

*YO, k5.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 12

*YO, k1, YO, k5.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 14

*(YO, k3) 2 times, k2tog.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 16

*YO, k2tog, k1, k2tog, YO, k2, k2tog.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 18

*YO, k1, YO, sk2p.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

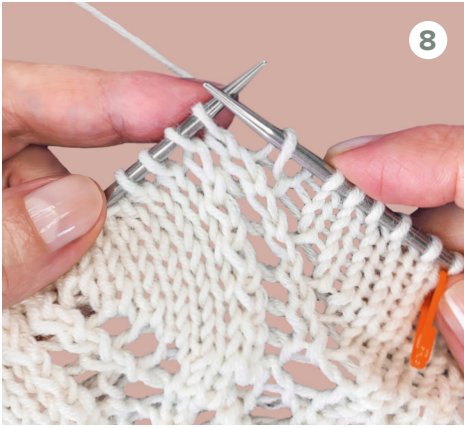
Rounds 19-21

K64. (Image 7)

Round 22

*YO, k1, YO, sk2p.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.
(Images 8-11)



Rounds 23-25

K all sts.

Round 26

*YO, k1, YO, k2tog, k1.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 28

*(K1, YO) 2 times, k2tog, k1.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 30

*K2, YO, k1, YO, k2tog, k1.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 32

*K3, YO, k1, YO, k2tog, k1.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 34

Change to circular needle.

With circular needle

*K4, YO, k1, YO, k2tog, k1.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 36

*K5, YO, k1, YO, k2tog, k1.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 38

*K6, YO, k1, YO, k2tog, k1.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 39

K176, remove sm.

K2 and place a sm (this now indicates the beginning of the round).

Round 40

*K4, sk2p, k4, YO.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 42

*K3, sk2p, k3, YO, k1, YO.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 44

*K2, sk2p, k2, YO, k3, YO.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 45

*K1, sk2p, k1, YO, k2tog, k1, k2tog, YO.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.



Round 48

*Sk2p, YO, k1, YO.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 50

*K1, YO, k7, YO.

Repeat from * to the end of the round.

Round 52

Bind off (stretchy bind off recommended)
and weave in your ends.

Wet the project slightly and let it dry flat.
