## Teapot Cozy

Knitting level: Advanced



This cozy features a series of intricate cable patterns that create a textured and inviting appearance. Each stitch challenges and engages, providing an enjoyable experience with a rewarding outcome.

Ideal for those who have mastered basic stitches and are ready to tackle more advanced techniques, this project will refine your skills and enhance your knitting repertoire.

## Materials:

- One skein of Cotton Blossom yarn
- US 6 ( 4 mm ) straight needles (from your previous boxes)
- Scissors


## Terms and abbreviations used:

- K - knit
- P - purl
. SI - slip
- C4F - cable 4 front (slip 2 sts on the front side of the work, k2, k2 from the slipped sts)
C4B - cable 4 back (slip 2 sts on the back side of the work, k2, k2 from the slipped sts)
C6F - cable 6 front (slip 3 sts on the front side of the work, k3, k3 from the slipped sts)
C6B - cable 6 back (slip 3 sts on the back side of the work, k3, k3 from the slipped sts)

P2, k6, p2, k4, p1, k1, p14, k1, p1, k4, p2, k6, p2.

## Row 5

K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k14, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2.

## Row 6

P2, C6F, p2, C4F, p1, k1, P6, slip 1 to the extra needle, hold in front of the work, k1, k stitchfrom extra needle, p6, k1, p1, C4F, p2, C6F, p2. (images 2, 3, 4, 5)


Row 7
K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k6, p2, k6, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2.

## Row 8

P2, k6, p2, k4, p1, k1, p5, slip next stitch to extra needle, hold in back of the work, k1, p stitch from extra needle, slip next stitch to extra needle, hold in front of work, p1, k stitch from extra needle, p5, k1, p1, k4, p2, k6, p2.

## Row 9

K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k5, p2, k1, p1, k5, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2. (image 6)


Row 10
P2, k6, p2, C4B, p1, k1, p4, slip next stitch to the extra needle, hold in back of work, k1, p stitch from extra needle, k1, p1, slip next stitch to the extra needle, hold in front of work, p1, k stitch from extra needle, p4, k1, p1, C4B, p2, k6, p2. (images 7, 8, 9, 10)


## Row 11

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K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k4, p2, k1, p1, k1, p1, k4, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2. (image 11)
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## Row 12

P2, k6, p2, k4, p1, k1, p3, slip next stitch to extra needle, hold in back of work, k1, p stitch from extra needle, $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$, p1, slip next stitch to extra needle, p1, k stitch from extra needle, p3, k1, p1, k4, p2, k6, p2.

Row 13
K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k3, p2, (k1, p1) 3 times, k3, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2.


Row 14
P2, C6B, p2, C2F, p1, k1, p2, slip next stitch on extra needle, hold in back of work, k1, p stitch from extra needle, (k1, p1) 3 times, slip st to an extra needle in front of the work, p1, k stitch from extra needle, p2, k1, p1, C2F, p2, C6B, p2.

Row 15
K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k2, p2, (k1, p1) 4 times, k2, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2. (image 12)

## Row 16

P2, k6, p2, k4, p1, k1, p1, slip next stitch to the extra needle, hold in back of work, k1, p1 from the extra needle, (k1, p1) 4 times, slip next stitch to the extra needle, p1, $k$ stitch from extra needle, p1, k1, p1, k4, p2, k6, p2.

## Row 17

K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k1, p2, (k1, p1) 5 times, k1, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2.

## Row 18

P2, k6, p2, C4B, p1, k1, p1, slip next stitch to extra needle, hold in front of work, p1, k stitch from extra needle, ( $\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ ) 4 times, slip next stitch to extra needle, hold in back of work, k1, p stitch from extra needle, p1, k1, p1, C4B, p2, k6, p2.

## Row 19

K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k2, p2, (k1, p1) 4 times, k2, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2.
Row 20
P2, k6, p2, k4, p1, k1, p2, slip next stitch to the extra needle, hold in front of work, p1, k stitch from extra needle, (p1, k1) 3 times, slip next stitch to the extra needle, hold in back of work, k1, p stitch from extra needle, p2, k1, p1, k4, p2, k6, p2.

## Row 21

K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k3, p2, (k1, p1) 3 times, k3, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2.

## Row 22

P2, C6F, p2, C4F, p1, k1, p3, slip next stitch to the extra needle, hold in front of work, p1, k stitch from extra needle, (p1, k1) twice, slip next stitch to extra needle, hold in back of work, k1, p stitch from extra needle, p3, k1, p1, C4F, p2, C6F, p2.

## Row 23

K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k4, p2, (k1, p1) 2 times, k4, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2.

## Row 24

P2, k6, p2, k4, p1, k1, p4, slip next stitch to extra needle, hold in front of work, p1, k stitch from extra needle, p1, k1, slip next stitch to extra needle, hold in back of work, k1, p stitch from extra needle, p4, k1, p1, k4, p2, k6, p2.

## Row 25

K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k5, p2, k1, p1, k5, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2.

## Row 26

P2, k6, p2, C4B, p1, k1, p5, slip next stitch to extra needle, hold in front of work, p1, k stitch from extra needle, slip next stitch to extra needle, hold in back of work, k1, p stitch from extra needle, p5, k1, p1, C4B, p2, k6, p2.

Row 27
K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k6, p2, k6, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2.

## Row 28

P2, k6, p2, k4, p1, k1, p6, k2, p6, k1, p1, k4, p2, k6, p2.
Row 29
K2, p6, k2, p4, k1, p1, k6, p2, k6, p1, k1, p4, k2, p6, k2. (image 13)

## Final row 1

P2, slip 3 sts to extra needle (hold in back of work), k3, k3 from the extra needle, p2, slip 2 to extra needle (hold in front of work), k2, k2 from the extra needle, p1, k1, p14, k1, p1, slip 2 to extra needle (hold in front of work), k2, k2 from the extra needle, p2, slip 3 sts to extra needle (hold in back of work), k3, k3 from the extra needle, p2.

Cast off. (image 15)


Place the teapot in the middle of your project, fold the project around, and mark places for the spout or handle. Sew the edges and leave openings for them. (images 16, 17, 18)


## Icord

Cast on 4.
*K4, sl 4sts from the right needle to left and repeat * these instructions till you reach your desired length. In this case, we knitted approximately 23 inches. (images 19, 20, 21, 22)


Put the icord in and out of the loops around the project, pull and make a knot. (images 23, 24)


## Pompom (optional)

Wrap the yarn around 4 fingers. Slide it off, take approximately 7 inches of yarn and wrap it in the middle, make several knots, take the scissors and cut the folded ends, cut extra ends, and make pompom round. Attach it with several knots into both ends of the icord. (images 25, 26, 27, 28, 29)
