# Project #3: Twisted elegance infinity scarf

### Knit level: Advanced

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Wrap yourself in the warmth and intricate beauty of our twisted elegance infinity scarf, a project designed to delight advanced knitters with its engaging patterns and cozy embrace.

Crafted with 100 grams of our softest Merino Mirage yarn, this infinity scarf is a testament to your knitting expertise!

Please note that the yarn color shown in the instructional photos **may vary** from the color included in your box.

#### Materials:

- Two skeins of Merino Mirage yarn
- · US size 10 (6mm) knitting needles
- $\cdot$  Sewing needle
- $\cdot$  Ruler
- · Scissors

### Terms used/Abbreviations (US terms):

- $\cdot$  K knit
- · P purl
- · Cast off
- · Cast on
- · St stitch
- · Sts stitches
- · SIS SUICHE

- K2tog knit two together
- · Pick up
- · Kfb knit front and back
- · P2tog purl two together

#### Casting on the stitches with icord

Cast on 4.

SI 1st st, Kfb, k2.





Do not turn the project around, slip 3 stitches without casting anything, back to the left hand needle.

\*kfb 1st st, k2, slip 3 loops back to the left needle.

Continue \*this pattern till you reach 113 stitches .

To join the end and beginning of the project and start knitting in circles, slip the 1st st from the left hand needle and pull the yarn over it. You will be left with 112 stitches. Place the marker to mark the beginning of the round. do not forget to slip the marker before beginning each round.



Round 1,2,3,4,5

K2, p2.

Round 6

\*K4, p2.

Repeat \*these instructions, after the last k4, before slipping the marker to the right hand needle, pick up two stitches from the last st. You will have 114 stitches in total.


Round 7

\*k4, p2.

Repeat \*these instructions till the end of the round.

Round 8 – (cable twist round).

\*Drop 2 stitches, slip 2 stitches from the left-hand needle to the right-hand needle, insert needle into the dropped stitches and slip them to the left-hand needle, slip two stitches from the right-hand needle back to the left-hand needle, k4, p2.



You may use sewing needle to hold the dropped stitches.



Repeat \*these instructions till the end of this round. Round 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 ,15 \*k4, p2 across the round.



Repeat rounds 8-15 till you make 7 cable twists in total. After you make 7th cable twist round, make two more rounds of k4, p2 repeat.

Next we will make 6 rounds of  $k^2$ , p2 repeat (p2tog in the 1st round's last two stitches to reduce the number of total stitches to 112).

#### **Icord cast off**

We will use icord cast off method to finish the scarf.

Turn the needles and place the needle with the working yarn on it in your left hand. Cast on 3 loops on the left-hand needle.

We will be knitting in circle, we just switched the places of the needles.

\*K2, k2tog, slip the 3 stitches in your right hand needle back onto the left hand needle.

Repeat \*these instructions till the end of the round.



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When you will be left with the last 3 stitches, cast off with any method. Sew the beginnings and end of the icords and weave in the extra yarn.
