Project #3: Twisty Cowl

Level: Advanced





Wrap yourself in this stunning crochet cowl! It's long enough to double-wrap for extra warmth on chilly days or to wear loose for a more relaxed look.

You'll start with a fun cross-stitch section that creates an interesting texture. Then, you'll move on to some lovely V-stitches that give a lacy, delicate look. Finally, you'll finish with clusters that add a chunky, cozy feel.

You can access your digital pattern with a **quick scan** of the **QR** code!



Materials:

- · 35g of Merino Majesty in pink (color 14393), 35g of Merino Majesty in cream (color 978), 35g of Merino Majesty in blue (color 14607).
- · US size 8 (5 mm) hook (from your previous boxes)
- · Scissors

Stitches and abbreviations used:

- · Ch chain
- · St(s) stitch(es)
- · SI-st slip stitch
- · Sc single crochet
- · Dc double crochet
- \cdot V st V stitch dc, ch1 and dc in the same st again
- Gauge:
- 12 sts and 8 rows of cross stitch in 4 inches

- · 2dc-cl 2 double crochet cluster *yo, insert the hook in the st, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops, repeat from * once more in the same st, yo, pull through remaining loops.
- · Cross stitch skip 1 st and dc in the next st, then dc in the skipped st
- · Rep repeat

Measurements:

22" x 9"

Section 1

With color 14393, ch29.

Row 1

Starting in the 2nd ch from the hook, 28sc.


Row 2

Ch1 and turn the work, dc in the 1st st.

*Cross st. Rep from * till the last st, dc in the last st. (Images 1-3)







Rows 3-15

Rep row 2. At the end of row 15, change to color 978 and cut color 14393. (Images 4, 5)

Section 2

Row 16

With color 978, ch3 (counts as 1st dc) and in the 3rd st from the base of the chain, V st, *skip 1 st, V st. Rep from * till the last st, dc in the last st. (Images 6-9)

Row 17

Ch3 and turn the work, *V st in each ch1 space. Rep from * till last st, dc in last st (top of ch3). (Image 10)

Rows 18-28

Rep row 17. Change to color 14607 at the end of the row 28.


Section 3


Row 29

Ch3, turn the work, *2dc-cl in ch1 space, ch1. Rep from * till last st, dc in the last st. (Images 11-17)

Row 30

Ch3, *2dc-cl in ch1 space, ch1. Rep from * till the last st, dc in the last st (top of ch3). (Images 18, 19)







Row 31

Ch3, *2dc-cl in ch1 space, ch1. Rep from * till Ch4, *2dc-cl in ch1 space, ch1. Rep from * the last st, dc in the last st. (Image 20)

Row 32

Ch1 and sc in each st and ch1 space. (26 sc) (Image 21)

Row 33

Ch4, (3ch count as dc, 4th ch counts as ch1), 2dc-cl in the 3rd st, *ch1, skip 1 st, 2dc-cl in the next st. Rep from * till the last st, dc in the last st. (Image 22)

Row 34


till last space, 2dc-cl, dc in the last st (3rd of ch4). (Image 23)

Row 35

Ch4, *2dc-cl in the next space, ch1. Rep from * till last space, 2dc-cl, dc in the last st.

Row 36

Ch1, sc in each st and ch1 space (27th in ch4 and 28th in ch3). (Image 24)



Row 37

Ch3, *2dc-cl in 2nd st, ch1 and skip 1 st. Rep from * till last st, dc in last st.

Row 38

Ch3, *2dc-cl in ch1 space, ch1. Rep from * till last st, dc in the last st.

Row 39

Ch3, *2dc-cl in ch1 space, ch1. Rep from * till last st, dc in the last st.

Row 40

Ch1, sc in each st and ch1 space. (28 sc)

Rows 41-44

Repeat rows 33-36. Do not cut the yarn. (Image 25)

Twist one side of the work as pictured and join the short ends by working sc through the sts of both ends. Turn the work so the join is to the inside, and the cowl is ready. (Images 26-29)
