# Project #1:

# Wall Hanging Flower

Crochet level: Beginner





Dive into this easy crochet project and make a charming wall-hanging flower! This pattern is perfect for adding a handmade touch to your home. You'll love seeing your skills come to life in this beautiful floral decoration.

#### **Materials:**

- · 10 grams of Cushy Soft in a purple color (312)
- · 10 grams of Cushy Soft in a yellow color (628)
- · 10 grams of Cushy Soft in a white color (390)
- · US size 4 (3.5 mm) crochet hook
- · Scissors
- · Sewing needle

# Terms used/Abbreviations (US terms):

· Magic circle

 $\cdot$  SI - slip stitch

· Ch - chain

· C - color

· St(s) - stitch(s)

- · Inc increase, make 2 sts in one st
- · Sc single crochet · Dc double crochet
- Dc2inc make 2dc in the same st
  Dc3inc make 3dc in the same st
- · Hdc half double crochet

#### Colors:

· Purple (312) · Yellow (628) · White (390)

#### **Flower**

## Start with the purple color (312).


Make a magic circle or alternately ch4 and sl st in the first st. (image 1)

#### **Round 1**

Sc8 in the circle. Sl in the 1st st. (image 2)

#### Round 2

Ch1, sc in the same st, inc in every stitch around, sl st in 1st st. Ch1 and fasten off (15 in total). (images 3, 4)




Take the yellow color (628).

# Round 3

SI st with color 628 in any stitch in the circle, 2sc in the same st,  $^*$  [hdc1, dc1, hdc1] in the next st, sc2 in the next st  $^*$ .


The first petal is done.

Repeat \* 4 more times (5 petals in total). (images 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11)




**Round 4** 

\*Sc in the 1st st of 1st petal, hdc2, dc3inc, hdc2, sc1. Repeat \* 4 more times. (image 12)



**Round 5** 

 $^*$ Sc2, (you can put a stitch marker on the 1st st), hdc1, dc1, dc3inc, dc1, hdc1, sc2. Repeat  $^*$  4 more times. (images 13, 14)





**Round 6** 

\*Sc2, dc2inc, dc2inc, dc2inc, dc3inc, dc2inc,, dc2inc, dc2inc, sc2.

Repeat \* 4 more times. (images 15, 16)





# **Background**

Take the purple color (312), ch28.

# Row 1

Color 312 - sc27 (start from 2nd st from the hook). (image 17)



# Row 2


Color 312 - ch1 and turn the work. Skip the 1st ch1 space \*sc3 (change the color while making the third sc – insert the hook and pull up a loop, you will have two loops on the hook, drop the yarn, grab another color with the hook, and pull through two loops).

**Note:** Repeat these instructions through the pattern and change the color on the third sc. When making single crochet stitches, keep the non-working yarn in the middle to carry it along. Non-working yarns will be hidden in the project.

Color 390 - sc3

Repeat \* 3 more times.

Color 312 - sc3 (images 18, 19, 20, 21)



#### Row 3

Ch1, turn your work, \*color 312 - sc3, color 390 - sc3.

Repeat \* 3 more times. Color 312 - sc3. (image 22)

#### Row 4

Ch1, \*color 312 - sc3, color 390 - sc3.

Repeat \* 3 more times. Color 312- sc3

#### Row 5

Ch1, \*color 312 - sc3, color 390 - sc3.

Repeat \* 3 more times. Color 312- Sc3, change to color 390 on the last sc.

## Row 6

Ch1, \* color 390- sc3, color 312 - sc3.

Repeat \* 3 more times. Color 390 - sc3. (image 23)





#### **Rows 7-9**

Repeat row 6, change the color to color 312 on the last sc of row 9.

#### **Rows 10-25**

Repeat rows 2-9.

# **Row 26**

Color 312 - ch1, sc27.

# **Row 27**

Ch25, sl in the last st of row 26.



Sew the flower to the background across the petals using a sewing needle. Weave in all loose ends. (images 25, 26)
