

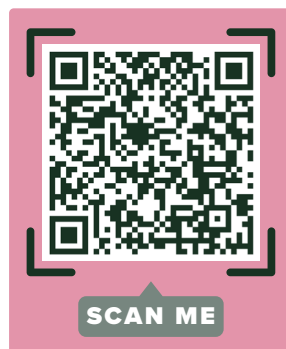
Project #3: Woven Storage Basket

Crochet level: Advanced



Challenge your crochet skills and create a stunning statement piece for your home. This advanced pattern guides you through to create a complex basket stitch and sturdy rope handles, resulting in a beautiful basket. Perfect for storing blankets, yarn, or other household items.

Materials:

- Woodland Whisper in Color 19 - 100g
- 5 mm crochet hook
- Stitch marker
- Sewing needle

Measurements:

- Height: 4 ½"
- Circumference: 21 ½"

Gauge:

- 16 sts and 7 rows per 4" using the basket stitch.

Stitches/abbreviations (US terms):

- St - stitch
- Sc - single crochet
- Dc - double crochet
- Ch - chain
- Mr - magic ring
- Sl-st - slip stitch
- BLO - back loop only
- Special stitch: Basket stitch –

Rounds 1 & 2: *Work 4dc in front posts, then 4dc in back posts.
Repeat from * to end of round.

Rounds 3 & 4: *Work 4dc in back posts, then 4 dc in front posts.
Repeat from * to end of round.

Round 1

Make mr and 6sc into it. Sl-st to first sc to join, and at the end of every round. (6 sc)

Round 2

Ch1 (does not count as a stitch throughout),
2sc into every st. (12 sc)

Round 3

Ch1, *sc 1, 2sc into next st. Repeat from
* to end of round. (18 sc)

Round 4

Ch1, *sc 2, 2sc into next st. Repeat from
* to end of round. (24 sc)

Round 5

Ch1, *sc 3, 2sc into next st. Repeat from
* to end of round. (30 sc) (Image 2)

Round 6

Ch1, *sc 4, 2sc into next st. Repeat from
* to end of round. (36 sc)

Round 7

Ch1, *sc 5, 2sc into next st. Repeat from
* to end of round. (42 sc)

Round 8

Ch1, *sc 6, 2sc into next st. Repeat from
* to end of round. (48 sc)

Round 9

Ch1, *sc 7, 2sc into next st. Repeat from
* to end of round. (54 sc)

Round 10

Ch1, *sc 8, 2sc into next st. Repeat from
* to end of round. (60 sc) (Image 3)

Round 11

Ch1, *sc 9, 2sc into next st. Repeat from
* to end of round. (66 sc)





Round 12

Ch1, *sc 10, 2sc into next st. Repeat from * to end of round. (72 sc)

Round 11

Ch1, sc all around.

Round 12

Ch1, sc BLO all around. (Image 4)

Round 13

Ch2, dc all around.

Rounds 14-24

Work the 4-row basket stitch pattern 2 ½ times or until your work measures 4 ½” from the start of the dc rows. When working the basket stitch rounds, there is

no need to join the rounds with sl-st or chs. (Images 5-7)

Round 25

Sc all around.

Basket handles

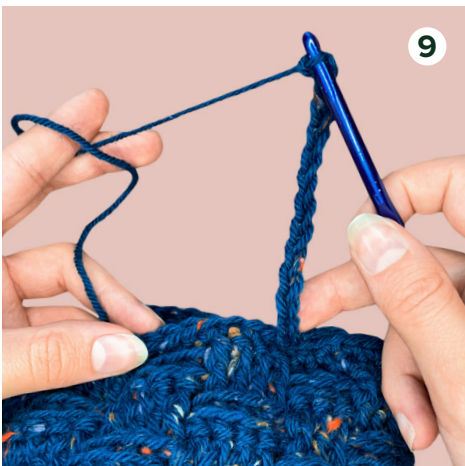
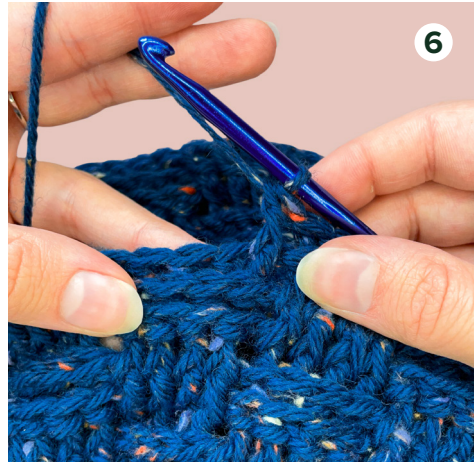
Round 26

Sc 25, ch15, skip 10 sts, and sl-st in the next st. Sc 25 (starting in the st you just sl-st into), ch15, skip 10 sts and sl-st in the first st. (Images 8-10)

Round 27

Ch2, dc around. When you reach the handles, work 25dc into each handle (working over the ch). Sl-st to the base of the chain, cut the yarn, and fasten off. (Image 11)

Weave in your ends and you are done!



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
